Generative Artificial Intelligence (GENAI)

Connects Transylvanian Saxon Cultural Heritage

Since the end of the 20th century, the Transylvanian-Saxon **cultural heritage** has been almost the only remaining bond of sympathy that holds the Transylvanian-Saxon **community** together and shapes the Transylvanian-Saxon **identity**. The **associations** and the **Internet** are the community's most important instruments. Thanks to **GENAI**, the Internet will in the future be a very powerful **digital communication space** for the appropriation, preservation and further development of the Transylvanian-Saxon cultural heritage.

These projects will discuss how the Transylvanian Saxons can preserve their **cultural independence** and what **tasks** and **challenges** arise for their organizations and all those committed to Transylvanian Saxon cultural heritage in the age of generative AI. The results should be presented multilingually in **German**, **English** and **Romanian**. The following **goals** could be realized in several projects:

- 2. Transylvanian Saxons A Portrait. Current Situation and Future Prospects
- 3. Digitization of Transylvanian-Saxon cultural heritage
- 4. Acquisition of public and private funding
- 1. The project "Generative Artificial Intelligence (GENAI) and Transylvanian-Saxon cultural heritage" aims to promote an ongoing discussion of the practical benefits and threats that GENAI brings with it for the appropriation, preservation and further development of Transylvanian-Saxon cultural heritage.
- 2. The book and internet project "Transylvanian Saxons A Portrait. Current Situation and Future Prospects" is intended to create a "visiting card" of the Transylvanian Saxons and their institutions worldwide.
- 3. The **digitization** of the Transylvanian-Saxon **cultural heritage** represents an outstanding measure for the future safeguarding and further development of the cultural heritage. The aim is to digitize and digitally publish the Transylvanian-Saxon cultural heritage as completely as possible.
- 4. The acquisition of **private and public funding** is necessary because these projects require extensive work and are very costly. Therefore, they cannot be carried out solely by volunteers.
